

Status of SB 2 Task Force

On behalf of the Orange County City Manager's Association, please accept our appreciation for your participation on the SB 2 City Managers/Planning Directors Task Force.

As you know, the Task Force has provided a useful forum for information sharing among cities as well as with the various non-profit and faith based organizations who serve the homeless population in Orange County. It has successfully served as a focal point for identifying and addressing potential conflicts between proposed zoning code provisions and the challenges of operating homeless shelters. Since the establishment of the Task Force almost 2 years ago, a good deal has been accomplished as evidenced by the fact that 32 of the 34 cities and the County of Orange have now either adopted or committed to public hearings for adoption of new SB 2 zoning code provisions.

While the central purpose of the Task Force has largely been accomplished, we recognize that there continues to be much to do. It is with this in mind that OCCMA is disbanding the SB 2 Task Force at this time with our sincere thanks for your efforts. The Association will consider the establishment of a standing Committee/Task Force within our organization to address homelessness.
