Cassie Eidem with South County Outreach

We are interviewing now for the 2 openings that we will have later this month.

Colleen Smagala with Anaheim Interfaith

We will have openings for 2 large family apartments approximately the end of March. A large family would be 5 to 8 people depending on the ages of the children.

Tiffany Tabares with WISE Place

We have openings for several women. They start off with a phone screen and then an in person interview. We are able to take a woman that is homeless for almost any reason. We often have space because they have to be pretty high functioning and able to work full time unless they are in our youth or senior program.

Judi Bambas at Fullerton Interfaith Emergency Services will have three openings by the end of next week (single women with children) and then hopefully the following week have another three. I'll keep you posted since I can't confirm due to the maintenance that is being done. I'm estimating these dates.
