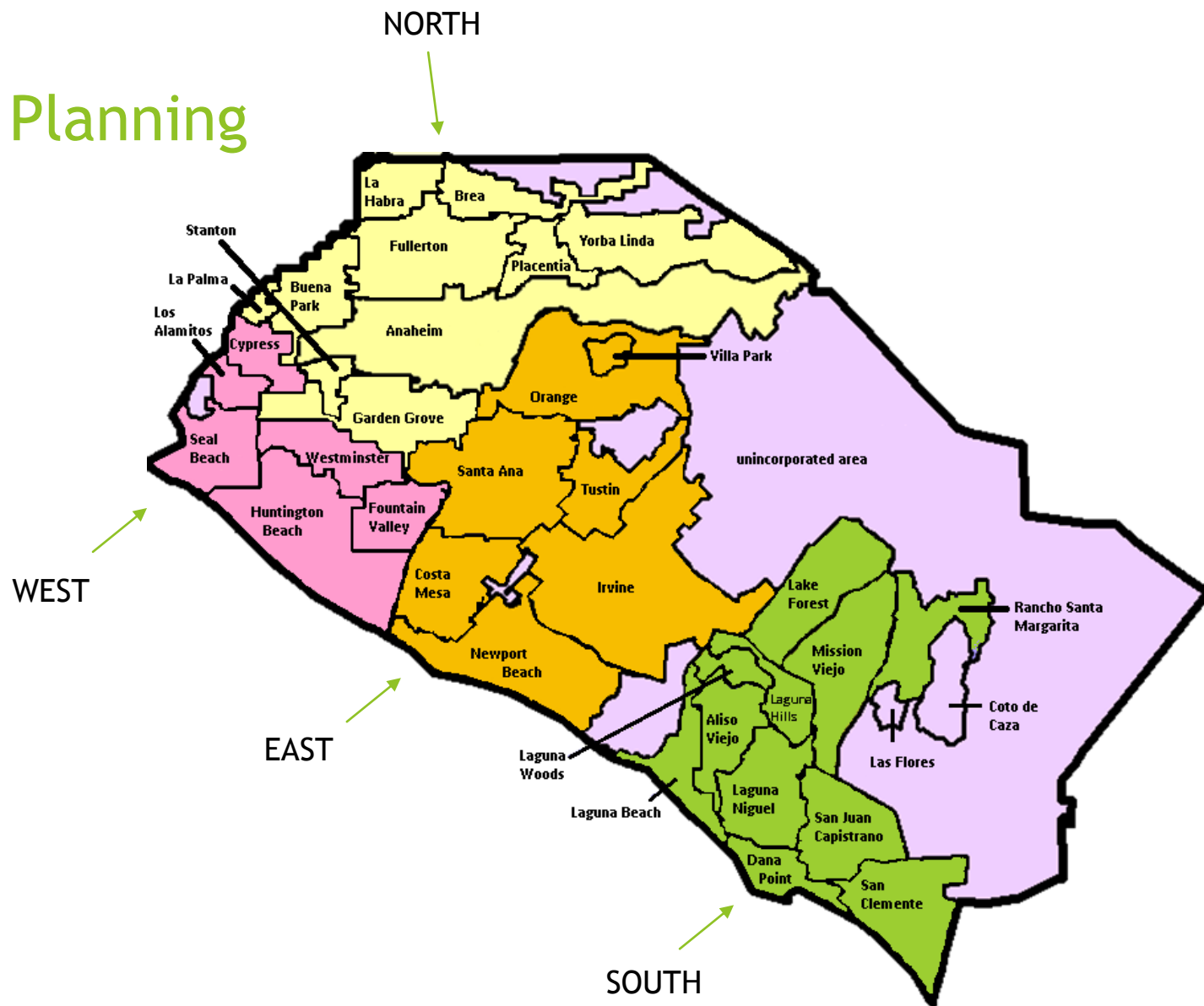

Written Standards

- ▶ PSH and RRH Written Standards to be presented to C2eH Executive Committee at the next scheduled meeting
 - ▶ Upon approval, to be presented to C2eH Board on September 25th (tentative date)
- ▶ 1st Draft of TH Written Standards was released on Thursday, August 20th
 - ▶ 2 weeks for feedback → due on Thursday, September 3rd
 - ▶ meeting to discuss and finalize → scheduled Thursday, September 10th
 - ▶ Final draft to be sent out to TH providers for their review

PRIORITY LIST

formerly known as the Waiting List

- ▶ Managing the Priority List:
 - ▶ 211 OC and County staff will manage and overseeing the priority list:
 - ▶ Outreach teams and emergency shelters should be putting people on the priority list
 - ▶ Providers should be taking people off the priority list

What HUD Funded Permanent Supportive Housing Providers can expect?

Until CE module goes live:

- ▶ 211OC staff and County staff to review and match clients to open inventory
- ▶ 211OC staff will email the outreach worker and the PSH HUD funded provider
 - ▶ Notification that a match has been made
 - ▶ Complete documentation of the client
 - ▶ CE Consent Form
 - ▶ VI-SPDAT
 - ▶ Housing Preference Survey
 - ▶ Evidence of Chronically Homeless - (disabling condition and length of homelessness)

HUD Funded Permanent Supportive Housing Providers

- ▶ HUD Funded PSH Providers for 2015 (as of August 26th 2015)
 - ▶ American Family Housing - No open vacancies
 - ▶ Anaheim Supportive Housing - No open vacancies
 - ▶ Colette's Children's Home - No open vacancies
 - ▶ Friendship Shelter - No open vacancies
 - ▶ Illumination Foundation - No open vacancies
 - ▶ John Henry Foundation - No open vacancies
 - ▶ Mercy House - Pending
 - ▶ Orange County Housing Authority - Pending
 - ▶ Veteran's First (until 2016) - No open vacancies

Bonus Project Collaborative Update

Mercy House is working with HUD on the following issues:

- ▶ Budget modifications to the PSH grants and as such contract has not been signed. HUD is holding this up a bit.
- ▶ Contradictory information received from HUD, as to whether or not the provider should enter into Sublease Agreements with clients or Occupancy Agreements. Unable to move forward with the new clients that are referred from CE until HUD provides a response.

CE Assessments

As of August 20th, 2015

- ▶ Total assessments received = 111
- ▶ Assessments with a score of 8 or above = 83
- ▶ Clients that are **Document Ready** = 32
 - ▶ CE Consent Form
 - ▶ VI-SPDAT
 - ▶ Housing Preference Survey
 - ▶ Evidence of Chronically Homeless - disabling condition and length of homelessness
- ▶ 1 Chronically Homeless Family Housed
- ▶ September 1st - 1st Chronically Homeless Individual expected to be Housed
