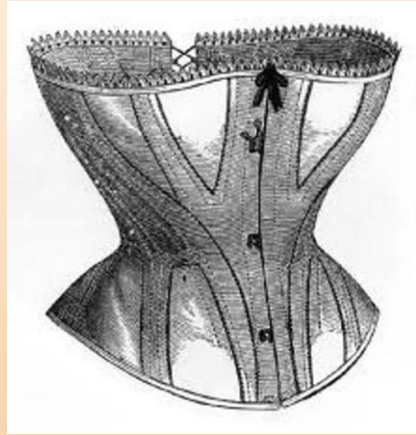

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Housing Placement Match Meetings

- ❖ Weekly Meetings with Outreach Staff and Housing Provider Staff at Table
- ❖ Successes:
 - ❖ 1st week – 26 people matched
 - ❖ 2nd week – 7 people matched
- ❖ Lessons “Learning”:
 - ❖ In 2nd meeting – top 37 people reviewed
 - ❖ 14 of top 40 remain on list with felony restrictions
 - ❖ 16 of top 40 remain on list due to housing preference
 - ❖ Need for early conversation regarding pet/service companion/therapy animal
 - ❖ Need for open conversation regarding felony disclosure and type of felony (violent/non-violent)
 - ❖ Need for having conversation about flexibility with housing area preference
 - ❖ Importance of getting clients document ready

Overall CE Numbers

184 people assessed

- 139 of them scored an 8 or higher (45 people scored <8); of those 139,
 - 15 housed
 - 35 recently matched to PSH
 - 2 approved for Shelter Plus Care (waiting for certificates)
 - 41 document ready but waiting for housing (including those who need felon friendly units)
 - 42 are still in the document gathering phase
 - 3 were housed in units outside of CE
 - 1 passed away
