Agenda

1. Introductions & Updates
 - a. CCH has small amount of RRH funding available for literally homeless family in Anaheim
 - i. Able to assist with deposit, 1st months' rent
 - b. Illumination Foundation has RRH funding available in Santa Ana
 - i. Able to assist with deposit, 1st months' rent, plus declining assistance
 - c. FF has RRH funding available to assist a family (no geography restrictions)
 - i. Requires 1 child (0-18?)
 - ii. Those who are literally homeless are prioritized
 - d. SPIN has RRH funding available to assist families (no geography restrictions)
 - e. Build Futures will also provide RRH assistance
 - i. Youth between ages of 18-24
 - f. FAM can also provide RRH assistance
2. RRH Asset Mapping
 - a. Madelyn (FF) shared the asset map and RRH program listing grid that has been created. Please let her know if you have any edits before it is finalized and shared with County and outside partners.
 - b. Final version will be cross referenced against 211OC database to ensure inclusion of all resources.
 - c. Housing Navigator call may be the place to work through creating a common definition for the term "identifying or securing" housing for the services provided section.
3. Coordinated Entry
 - a. Liz (FF) introduced a proposal to use the RRH Subcommittee meetings as a platform for the iterative development process to begin the RRH component of Coordinated Entry.
 - b. Kristin (211OC) shared that the Subcommittee would be a great primary source for developing:
 - i. RRH Policies and Procedures Recommendations

- ii. Identifying nationwide RRH best practices and standardization tools that could be lifted and shifted on to our CE process.
 - c. Kathy (BF) also noted that there was a need for assessing mental health and substance use supports that are available along with advocacy work for those gaps in service.
 - d. Liz (FF) agreed that those inputs were also needed and recommended that action plans be developed and brought back to the group so that the two efforts could work in tandem.
 - e. The group around the table felt that they would be able to support the CE work with a goal of an RRH Policies being presented for provider review at the March CE meeting with the hopes of a final RRH Policy Recommendation going to the Commission to End Homelessness in June 2016.
 - i. This ambitious goal may require an Ad Hoc group convening in the off months to push this process forward.
